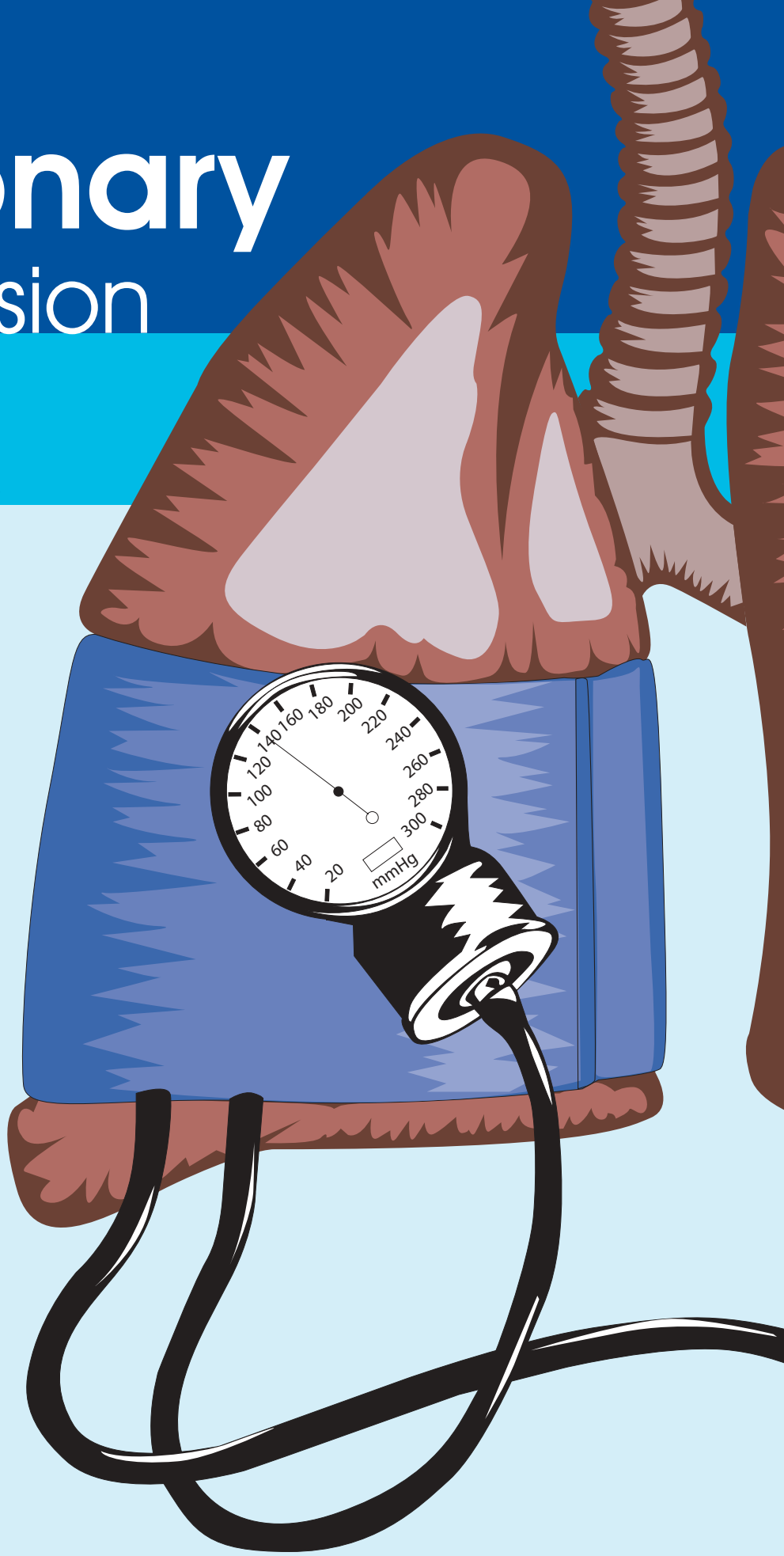


Pulmonary Hypertension

The other high blood pressure

Often misunderstood and missed in diagnosis, **Pulmonary Hypertension** is an elevation of pressure only in the blood flowing within the arteries of the lungs. It is NOT the kind of blood pressure that's measured with a cuff on your arm.

If you have diagnosed shortness of breath, or shortness of breath that is not improving with treatment, talk to your doctor about the possibility of **Pulmonary Hypertension**.
